Q1. Are There New Start Times?

Impact (11's-14's) will now start at 8:00pm

Impact + (15's-18's) will now start at 9:00pm

We've pushed the groups back by half an hour so that Roots (7-11's) can clean the hall before we use it (as we are now in the main hall).

The 30 minutes that we lose will be the 8:30-9:00pm slot, where the two groups mix. Running this just isn't possible right now.

Q2. What Time Is Pick Up?

Parents must arrive within the last 10 minutes of our groups.

Although our sessions end at 9:00pm & 10:00pm, this is the absolute latest time for pick ups.

This is so we can stagger exits, and avoid gatherings outside of the hall.

Q3. I've Arrived: Now What?

There will be separate entrances for boys & girls, to help clearly define our bubbles.

Boys enter through the Wingate Road entrance.
Girls enter through the Dundonald Road entrance.

Hand sanitiser must be used upon entry.

Q4. How Big Are The Groups?

We can create bubbles of up to 15 young people. We will do this by dividing the main hall.

This helps minimise the amount of contact each young person has with anyone outside of their bubble.

Everyone must stay socially distant (2m or 1m+ with mitigations) even within these bubbles.

Q5. Do We Need Masks?

Masks are not necessary for Impact as we are an Out of School Groups that can maintain social distancing at all times.

However, please do bring a mask - as we may try to lead small group studies from 1m+ with this mitigation.

Even if we choose to have some of these studies on Sudley Field in warmer weather - we may still make the use of masks.

Q6. Will We Stay In The Hall?

We may split into smaller groups and walk to Sudley Field and study the Bible there if the weather permits.

We will have to stay socially distanced at all times, however the rule of 6 will not apply to Out Of School groups.

Q7. Will There Be A Register?

We will keep details of the young people & leaders who attend each week.

We will note where they were seated, and who else is in their bubble.

Q8. Can I Give Lifts?

We strongly discourage car sharing between parents.

We know that this is usually a great way of helping one another with pick ups & drop offs, but given the risk, it is not a safe option.

We also discourage the use of public transport to get to and from Impact.

Q9. Where Do I Exit The Hall?

Young people will exit through the same doors they entered through.

Hand sanitizer must be used upon exit of the building.
